## Ethan's short but impressive hockey biography

Ethan started playing hockey at the age of nine where he played in the local youth and development competitions.

**Club Competition** - Signs of his natural ability to hockey were clear from the first day he attended a session. His first remarkable performance was displayed when playing with his former club at a development trip to Lisbon, Portugal in October 2017. It was impressive to see the youngest and smallest player on the pitch carrying such threating offensive

play which had the opposing team on their toes for the full 60 minutes.

International Competition (Bulgaria) - In July 2019, Ethan was selected as one of the ten team players participating in the EuroHockey5s U16 Championship II.



A very challenging competition where Gibraltar faced teams from Bulgaria, Russia, Armenia, Georgia and Slovenia. His performance was outstanding and scored a total of 7 goals throughout the competition.



A competition which ended with Gibraltar taking home 3<sup>rd</sup> place and Ethan's first official EuroHockey medal.

**International Competition (Scotland)** Opportunities have continued to come Ethan's way where he got selected to participate with the men's senior team at the EuroHockey Qualifier Championships in August 2022 in Glasgow, Scotland. At the young age of just 17, having made the senior men's team and being a key threating player against teams like Wales, Scotland and Switzerland is simply outstanding.
